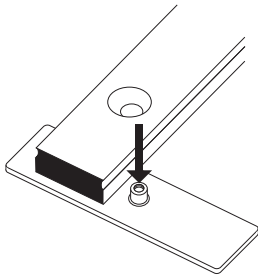
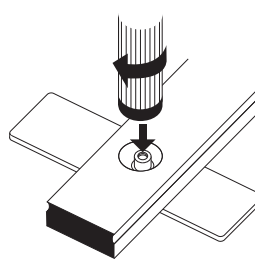


## Assembly Instructions for: **GREAT WALL BANNER**



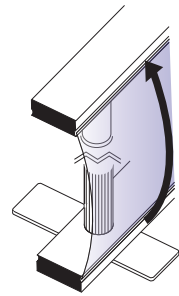
**Step 1**

Place large foot plate on the floor with nut facing up. Place bottom rail (small hole first) over nut as shown.



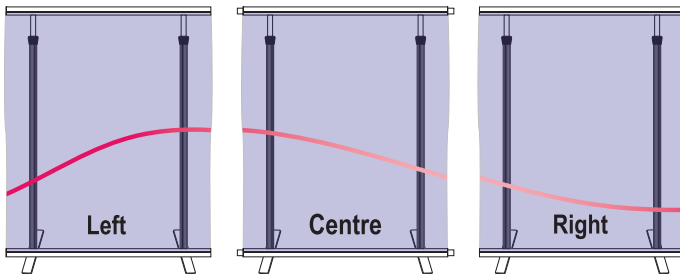
**Step 2**

Position pole within the larger hole and screw into nut. Turn in a clockwise direction to secure but do not over tighten.



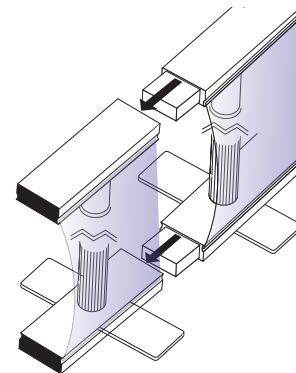
**Step 3**

Unroll banner and place top rail onto the secured pole.



**Step 4**

Position each banner LEFT, CENTRE and RIGHT.  
 (You may have more or less banner sections depending on your banner width)

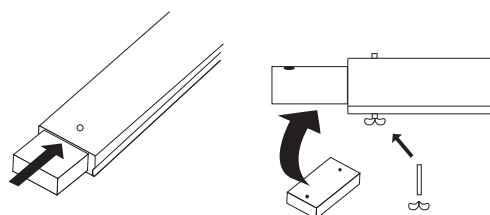


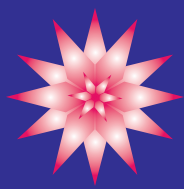
**Step 5**

Join the banner rails together by simply pushing the white silicone joiner into the adjoining rail.

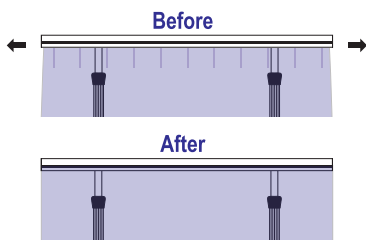
**\* Removable Joiners:**

Your Great Wall banner may contain optional "Removable Joiners". All Great Wall banners are provided with removable joiners in a separate clear plastic bag. Refer to the following instructions to insert removable joiners.



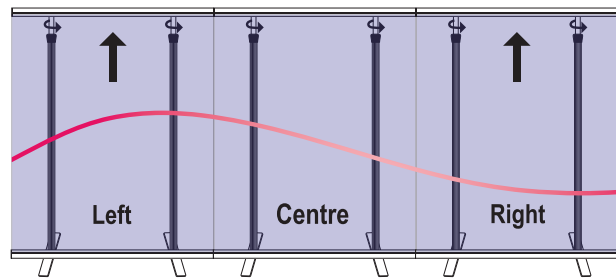


## Assembly Instructions for: **GREAT WALL BANNER**



**Step 6**

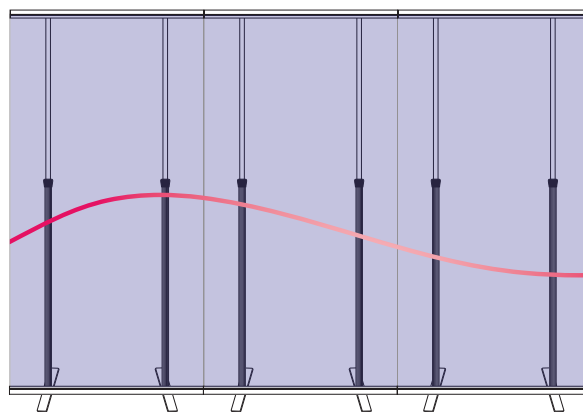
Smooth and pull the banner at each side of the banner so that it presents smoothly. This helps to pull any kinks out of the banner.



**Step 7**

(Advise 2 person assembly for 3m + walls)

Once all banners are slotted together, twist and turn all banner poles to unlock. Only raise the 2 outside banners about half way (don't worry about the centre ones until the 2 outside ones are raised). Lock the poles by twisting in small sections, locking poles on left and right banner after each movement. Raise the banners 1m at a time. If 2 people do this carefully, the middle banner will be raised at the same time and all you will need to do is twist & Lock the poles



**Step 8**

Now that all the banners are erected, adjust the images at the top and bottom to make sure they are all evenly lined up. If needed gently release the tension of each pole and gently slide the banners to meet so they match perfectly. Re-tension the banner when you have done this.
